WHAT KIND OF EXAMPLE ARE YOU? (1)

Be an example. 1 Timothy 4:12



Andrew Murray wrote, 'God has no more precious gift than a man who lives as an embodiment of His will, and inspires those around him with the faith of what grace can do.'

When Paul writes, 'Be an example,' he means 'be a role model.' The first car off the assembly line is a prototype of all that follows. Dressmakers study the pattern, and then design the garment accordingly.

The word ideal sounds lofty, and it is. But even if you don't achieve the ideal, it should still be your goal.

What Paul was saying to young Timothy was, 'When you talk about Jesus, people should see so much of Him in your life that they desire to know Him. When you talk about faith, the evidence of it should be so compelling that they want to live by it.'
