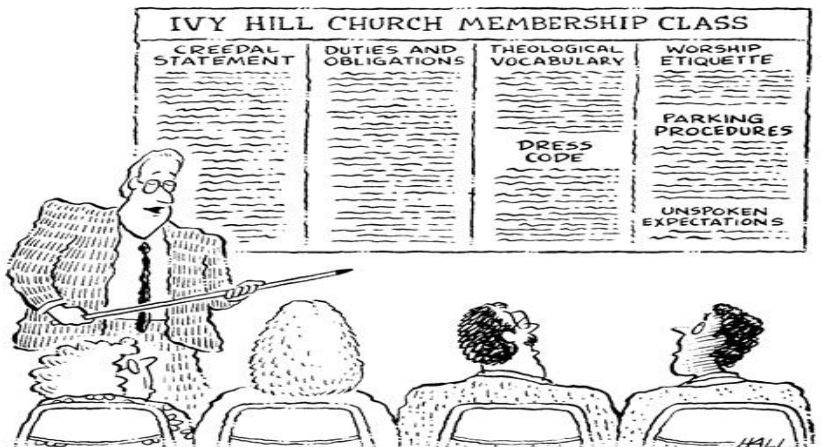
DANCE AND DINNER NIGHT
