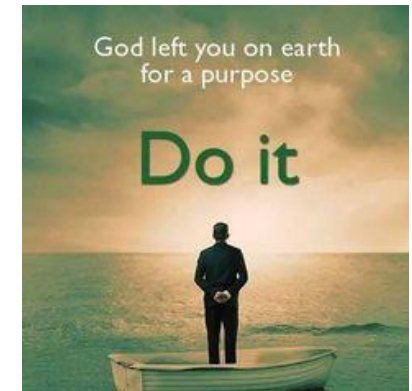

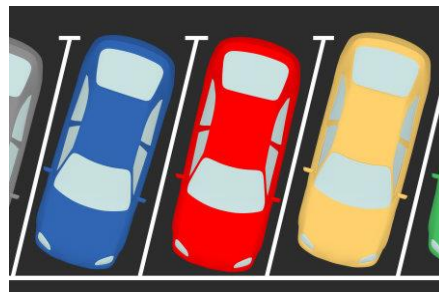

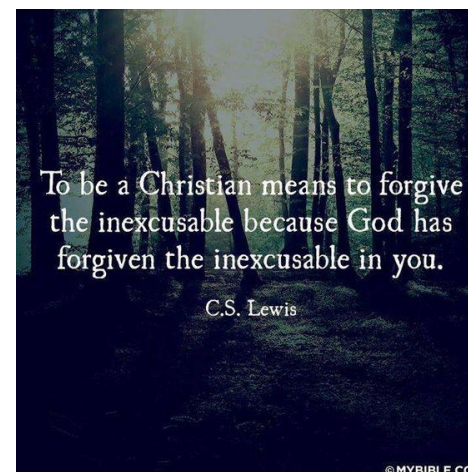


## Have you found your calling

'...and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with wisdom, with understanding, with knowledge and with all kinds of skills...'Exodus 31:3 NIV

Often people think that to 'live for God' means working full-time job for a church or missions group. But that's totally not the case...even in Bible times: Nehemiah was called to build walls, Daniel worked for the government, Luke was a first century doctor. Your calling is usually wrapped up in your job, whether it's in the church environment or not. Some other thoughts when considering your 'calling': (1) Remember, your past doesn't disqualify you from fulfilling your God-given destiny. Paul wrote, '...I hunted down his people, harming them in every way I could...' (1 Timothy 1:13 TLB). Today, the writings of fourteen of the twenty-seven books of the new Testament are attributed to him. (2) Your standard CV does not determine your future! Your calling may involve a complete change of direction. (3) God may call you to a job that looks too big for you. Why? That way you'll never forget where your strength and success come from. (4) Your calling is not a general advert for anyone to respond to, it's specifically for you. When you do something you are truly called to do, you will know and experience the real lasting pleasure of God. So what now? Whether you have found your 'calling' or are still not sure, trust God to show you what to do. When you demonstrate your faith and Christian character and use your income to fulfil God's purpose, you are as 'called' as a pastor or missionary. Shine for God, whatever you do!
