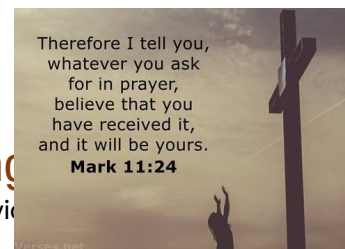


praying for others
